### 2019 CHANGES TO TEXAS TRAIL CHALLENGE CLUB'S RULE BOOK

#### **SECTION 2 – MEMBERSHIP**

### 2.1 Full Membership

Renew annually on December 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and can be paid either online or at any ride.

#### 2.4 - Ride Fees

Prepayment of the ride fee must be received 30 days prior to the ride in order to retain your reservation. If prepayment is not received 30 days prior to ride, the reservation will be dropped and will be given to members on the waiting list. The \$10 discount will not be applied if ride fee paid less than 30 days from ride.

## **SECTION 3 – GENERAL RULES**

## 3.7 - Ride Management

d) Each TTCC ride may have up to 65 riders subject to ride manager's discretion. If 65 riders attend, an additional judge will be needed. All judges and secretaries will receive additional payment if there are 65 riders.

#### **SECTION 4 – DIVISIONS & CLASSES**

## 4.2 - Age Classifications

- a) Tenderfoot Riders will be divided into three classifications:
  - i. 8-17 = Junior
  - ii. 18 61 = Adult
  - iii. 62 plus = Senior
- b) Maverick and Horseman Riders will be divided into two classifications:
  - i. 18 61 = Adult
  - j. 62 plus = Senior

## **SECTION 5 - SCORING**

### 5.6 Year-End Awards

If a rider moves up or down a division, they will take all accumulated points with them to the new division and be eligible for year-end awards in the division that represent s 40% of year's rides attended.

Riders must complete 50% of the year's rides to be eligible for Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, High Point, and Reserve High Point.

# 5.7 - Worker Average Score

- b) Must complete 8 or 40% of year's rides to be eligible for Year-End Awards including work weekends.
- c) (If they have ridden 8/40% of year's rides, no average is used.)
